Blackdown distillery, like Marriott is a family run business with its roots dating back to 1985 when our winery-distillery was originally founded. Today, it is an innovative award-winning producer of finely crafted spirits, creators of unique drinks striving for quality, refinement and provenance.

Nestled within the picturesque foothills of Blackdown Hill, South Downs National Park, West Sussex.

The luxurious collection of distinctive spirits are handcrafted in small batches in the oldest winery-distillery in Sussex, can only be described as poetic, set amid a sprawling ancient woodland near where Lord Alfred Tennyson once lived; writer of such epic works as Charge of the Light Brigade.

*But by the 1860's, a few houses had begun to label their wines "dry" in response
to a new trend, forested by the British, towards a drier and more
mature type of Champagne.*

*There is more complexity to Champagne than we are aware of.
In this menu, vintage Champagne takes on a new meaning and we are privileged
to take you back to 1982 to discover some of the rare and unique vintages
available up until the present day.*

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Perrier Jouët

Founded in 1811 in Epernay, Maison Perrier-Jouët is one of France's most historic champagne houses, but also one of its most distinctive, renowned for its elegant floral champagnes which reveal the true essence of the Chardonnay grape. A free spirit in Champagne, Perrier-Jouët has been profoundly, influenced by its founders' love of nature and art – twin inspirations which allow it to create, exceptional experiences and moments of beauty and wonder.

Appropriately, a House whose champagnes would celebrate life's precious moments began with a wedding: that of Pierre-Nicolas Perrier and Rose-Adélaïde Jouët – a couple united by a love of nature, a passion for champagne and a bold, entrepreneurial vision. Together, they pioneered new ways of nurturing vines and managing vineyards, quickly identifying the Côte des Blancs, to the south of Epernay, as an ideal terroir to reveal the rich floral nuances of Chardonnay – the emblematic grape which, right from the start, would be synonymous with Perrier-Jouët.

In keeping with its free spirit and meticulous attention to detail, Perrier-Jouët has always created tailor-made cuvées for individual clients or markets. In 1846, it laid down a landmark in the history of champagne by developing the world's first lightly sweetened cuvee for British champagne lovers, who preferred drier styles. In 1902, Art Nouveau master Emile Gallé created the delicate spray of Japanese white anemones that would become the iconic emblem of Maison Perrier-Jouët and its legendary Perrier-Jouët Belle Epoque vintage cuvées.

As Perrier-Jouët seventh cellar master, I am delighted to perpetuate its heritage and to partner with the Governor House. I hope you enjoy our floral and intricate cuvées in these beautiful surroundings.

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Nyetimber

For over 30 years, Nyetimber has had a single aim: to make the finest English sparkling wine, one to rival the very best in the world. A true pioneer, Nyetimber was the first producer of English sparkling wine to exclusively grow the three celebrated grape varieties: Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Nyetimber is made from one hundred percent estate-grown grapes and is regarded as England's finest sparkling wine.

Nyetimber uses only its own grapes from its own vineyards, each of which was deliberately selected to be south-facing with either sandy or chalk soils. Nyetimber vineyards enjoy a special microclimate that shelters our vines from coastal winds to ensure the ideal conditions for optimal ripening.

Prior to harvest, the grapes are tasted to ensure the best flavour development before picking. Every single grape is picked by hand at the optimal time, a decision that is made on a parcel by parcel basis.

All wines are crafted according to the strict rules of the traditional method, aged for extended periods of time on the lees and given post-disgorgement time before release. Nyetimber wines have successively won gold medals at prestigious international competitions. We have selected some of these extraordinary back vintages for your enjoyment.

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Deutz

Our aim at Champagne Deutz is to produce cuvées of understated excellence. Founded in 1838, our House is situated among the vineyards of one of the region's greatest villages: Ay-Champagne. Here we source grapes from the finest crus to produce small quantities of exceptional Champagne, always striving for the traditional Deutz style of finesse and balance.

Deutz was founded in 1838 through the association of William Deutz and Pierre-Hubert Geldermann. Convinced that a fine vineyard was the cornerstone of great wines, they started buying top quality plots and making wine. It was not long before Deutz had an international reputation, during the late 1800's it was the Champagne of choice for the British Royal Family, gracing dinner tables at many royal functions and being the Champagne served to guests at Queen Victoria's Jubilee in 1887.

We are immensely proud of our history at Deutz, reminding ourselves that everything we do today must be true to the values of those that have preceded us. It makes me particularly happy to be working with Grosvenor House, whose rich and long history includes many enviable royal connections of their own. I find many similarities between Grosvenor House's motto of "Excellence without extravagance" and our own aims stated at the top of this page. I hope that as you sit in these wonderful surroundings and taste our cuvées you will appreciate the fruits of our collective endeavours.
